INFORMATION SHEET FOR JULY/AUGUST 2025

1. Hin Ann Huay Kuan and Hong School 105th Anniversary Celebrations

Hin Ann Huay Kuan and Hong Wen School will be celebrating our 105th Anniversary with a Gala Dinner on 12 July 2025. The theme for the Celebrations is Hin Ann Hong Wen: Excellence our Quest.

Grassroots Adviser to Jalan Besar GRC (Whampoa Ward), Mr Shawn Loh, will grace the occasion as Guest-of-Honour.

Leading to the celebrations on 12 July, our students have been involved in some of the following ways:

- Submit art pieces for displays on the night of the dinner
- Pen their well-wishes for the Huay Kuan and School
- Design and paint square tiles for a display wall to commemorate our 105th Anniversary

Our students from Chinese Drums, Chinese Orchestra, Guzheng, Chinese Dance, Choir, Wushu, a Primary 2 class (Clapper) and representatives from the Primary 3 Chinese Cultural Ambassadors (Puxian Opera) will also be performing at the Concert held 12 July.

4. **Temperature-taking Exercise**

There will be a Temperature-taking Exercise on Wednesday 9 July 2025. This routine serves to educate our students on the need to take responsibility for their own health and social responsibility for the health of others, and also to be able to resume temperature-taking should the need arises. Parents, please remind your child to bring his/her working thermometer with him/her on that day.

All Primary 1 students were given an Oral Digital Thermometer (ODT) each for the Temperature-Taking Exercise (TTE) earlier this year and was kept by the Form Teachers. The ODTs will be given back to the Primary 1 students after the TTE in July.

5. **Annual School-Based Health Screening in Primary Schools**

The School Health Service will be visiting Hong Wen School from Tuesday, 15 July 2025 to Thursday, 24 July 2025 to conduct the annual health screening exercise for all students.

- A message to all Parents from the Health Promotion Board (HPB) listing the different services for the different levels was sent out via Parents Gateway on Monday, 26 May 2025
- Immunisation is scheduled for Primary 1 and Primary 5 students only
- If your child/ward is in Primary 1 or Primary 5, please access the HPB's Child Consent Portal to submit the online consent before the start of the Health Screening exercise
- Only Primary 5 students are to submit their Health Booklets to their Form Teachers by Friday, 11 July 2025

Your child/ward will be informed of the screening schedule nearer the date.

6. **Commemoration of Racial Harmony Day (RHD) – Monday 21 July 2025**

The school will commemorate RHD on Monday, 21 July 2025. This year's theme, "Our People, Our Tapestry", reminds us of the strength and beauty of our multicultural heritage. Through mutual understanding and respect, we can continue to build a harmonious and united community.

There will be an assembly programme and recess activities to help students appreciate racial harmony and multiculturalism. Students are to report in their school uniforms.

7. **Monthly Focal Value for July – Compassion**

The Monthly Focal Value Programme aims to build the character of our students by purposefully instilling in them our school core values. In July, we will be focusing on the value of "Compassion". We believe that fostering compassion is a vital aspect of our students' character development. Compassion enables our students to empathise with others, show kindness, and offer support to those in need. This valuable trait not only strengthens interpersonal relationships but also contributes to a caring and inclusive learning environment.

We seek your partnership in integrating this value into your child's daily life at home. The table below illustrates how your child can demonstrate compassion in his/her day-to-day interactions with his/her family members. Parents can also refer to page 14 of the school diary for the same table.

Discussing acts of kindness, encouraging empathy towards others, and highlighting instances where compassion made a difference can make a significant impact. By emphasizing compassion, parents play a crucial role in instilling these values in their children.

8. **Phase 1 Registration for 2025 Exercise**

The Phase 1 registration is for a Singapore Citizen (SC) or Permanent Resident (PR) child born between 2 January 2019 and 1 January 2020 (both dates inclusive) and has an older sibling currently studying in our primary school.

Parents who are registering your child under Phase 1 are to register online (on your own) during the Phase 1 registration period **from 9am on 1 July 2025 to 4.30pm on 3 July 2025.**

If your child is a non-SC/non-PR, your child will not be eligible for registration at Phase 1 or Phase 2. The school has informed earlier that parents need to submit an online Indication of Interest from 9am on 27 May to 4.30pm on 2 June 2025.

4. 体温检测（7月9日—星期三）

学生将于7月9日（星期三）进行体温检测，这个例常的检测旨在教育学生要对自己和他人的健康负责，并让他们做好重启日常体温测量的准备。请家长提醒孩子当天携带一个操作正常的温度计来学校。（注：老师已收集了一年级学生的温度计，检测后将把温度计归还学生。）

5. 常年校内健康检查

新加坡保健促进局的学校健康服务团队将于7月15日至7月24日到本校为我校学生提供一年一次的健康体检。

有关新加坡保健促进局对于各年级提供的体检项目，学校已在5月26日通过“家长联通”（Parents Gateway）应用程序通知家长。

只有小学一年级及五年级的学生会有免疫接种。如果您的孩子就读一年级或五年级，请在您的孩子体检之前登入新加坡保健促进局的网上平台给予您的许可。

只有一和五年级的学生需要在7月11日（星期五）之前，把身体健康册子交给级任老师。您的孩子会在稍后收到有关检查的时间表。

6. 种族和谐日（7月21日—星期一）

每年7月21日是种族和谐日，我校将于7月21日（星期一）纪念该节日。今年的主题“多元共融 同心织锦”，反应了我国各种族的独特性，但又能融洽地相处，一同打造一个和谐的社会。当天，我校将通过周会与休息节举办不同的活动，让学生更深入地了解种族和谐、多元文化和社会凝聚力的重要性。学生于这一天不必换上各种族的传统服装，穿校服即可。

7. 七月份月度焦点价值观 - 关爱
