**(1) Public Holiday / School Holiday**

**(2) Curtailment of School Hours and School Holiday for General Elections (GE) 2025**

In view of the upcoming GE2025, the school will be making the following arrangements:

**(a) Curtailment of School Hours – Friday, 2 May 2025**

Students are to report to school as usual at 7.30 a.m. on that day and will be dismissed based on the staggered timings below. Kindly ensure that arrangement is made for your child/ward. For students taking the school bus, the school bus operators have been informed of the dismissal time.

- Primary 1 and 2: 10.25 a.m.
- Primary 3 and 4: 10.30 a.m.
- Primary 5 and 6: 10.35 a.m.

Lessons will follow the usual Friday timetable for periods 1 to 7. As the school canteen will not be open on that day, students are encouraged to have their breakfast before coming to school. Students will have a Take 5 in class at about 9 a.m. Please ensure that your child brings along a light snack.

**(b) Student Care Centre and General Office Operations – Friday, 2 May 2025**

- The Student Care Centre (Little Professor) will remain open until 6.00 p.m.
- The General Office will close earlier, at 12.00 noon.

**(c) Polling Day and School Holiday**

Polling Day, which falls on Saturday, 3 May 2025, is a public holiday. As this public holiday falls on a Saturday, Monday, 5 May 2025, will be a school holiday (off-in-lieu) for all staff and students. The school will resume on Tuesday, 6 May 2025.

**(3) P3 and P4 Applied Learning Programme**

The Primary 3 and 4 students will be participating in their Applied Learning Programme (ALP) during Term 2, Weeks 9 and 10. Over the two weeks, students will be introduced to a Modified Design Thinking process and will explore themes related to environmental sustainability. Through these hands-on experiences, they will gain deeper insights into how they can contribute positively to the world around them. The ALP also aims to nurture 21st Century Competencies (E21CC) and foster essential learning dispositions such as critical thinking, communication, and collaboration.

**(4) e-Parent-Child-Teacher-Conference (e-PCTC) Session on 30 May 2025**

The e-PCTC session will be held virtually on Friday, 30 May 2025 (8.00am to 3.00pm). More information on the booking process will be given via the Parents Gateway at a later date. Students need not come to school Friday, 30 May 2025.

**(5) Space for Physical, Aesthetics & Character Exhibition (S.P.A.C.E.) 2025**

We will be holding our Annual Learning Carnival for Physical Education and Aesthetics at the end of Term 2. Encapsulated by the acronym "S.P.A.C.E", the learning carnival aims to promote physical activities and artistic expression as well as develop excellence, integrity and perseverance in character. A variety of Physical Education, Art and Music-related activities have been planned as shown in the table below.

**(6) P6 Supplementary Classes (26 – 27 June 2025)**

To better support our Primary 6 students in their preparation for the PSLE, the subject teachers will be conducting supplementary classes in the mornings of the above-mentioned days. Please ensure that your child/ward attend the classes punctually. Consent forms and more information will be given before the end of the term. For students involved in the practice for our 105<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Concert, they will only join the practice at the end of the Supplementary lessons.

**(7) End-of-Term 2 School Holiday and Travel Declaration**

Please be informed that the End-of-Term 2 school holidays will be from Saturday 31 May to Sunday 29 June 2025. We seek your support in making a travel declaration for your child if he/she is travelling during the school holidays via Parents Gateway under **<Services> => <Declare Travels>**. We wish you and your family a quality time of bonding in the coming June school holidays.

**(8) Support at Home for Cyber Wellness**

As the use of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) becomes increasingly pervasive, the school will continue our efforts in promoting cyber wellness among our students. #### 1) 公共假期 / 学校假期

#### 2) 2025 年全国大选假期及调整放学时间

由于全国大选的关系，学校将在大选前夕，5月2日(星期五)做出以下安排：

##### a) 调整放学时间(5月2日，星期五)

学生照常于7时30分到学校上课，并根据以下时间放学，请为孩子做出接送安排。校方也通知了所有校车司机调整后的放学时间。

- 一年级和二年级：10时25分

3) 三、四年级应用学习项目

三年级和四年级的学生将在第二学段的第9和第10周参与应用学习项目（ALP）。随着年中考试的取消，项目将在常规课程时间内进行。在这两周中，学生将学习一套改良版的设计思维流程，并围绕环境可持续性主题展开探索。通过动手实践，他们将更深入地认识自己如何为身边的环境带来积极改变。该项目也致力于培养学生的21世纪技能（E21CC），包括批判性思维、沟通与协作等关键学习能力。

4) 线上教师、家长、学生会议（5月30日）

#### 9) 台湾学习之旅及成都线上学习之旅
