(2) P3 and P4 Applied Learning Programme

The Primary 3 and 4 students will be participating in their Applied Learning Programme (ALP) during Term 2, Weeks 9 and 10. Over the two weeks, students will be introduced to a Modified Design Thinking process and will explore themes related to environmental sustainability. Through these hands-on experiences, they will gain deeper insights into how they can contribute positively to the world around them. The ALP also aims to nurture emerging 21st Century Competencies (E21CC) and foster essential learning dispositions such as critical thinking, communication, and collaboration.

(3) e-Parent-Child-Teacher-Conference (e-PCTC) Session on 29 May 2026

The e-PCTC session will be held virtually on Friday, 29 May 2026 (8.00am to 3.00pm). More information on the booking process will be given via the Parents Gateway at a later date. Students need not come to school on Friday 29 May 2026.

(4) Online Briefing for Parents of Primary 3 on 29 May 2026

There will be a briefing for parents in the afternoon of 29 May 2026. This is solely meant for parents of Primary 3 children. Details will be made known at a later date.

(5) Space for Physical, Aesthetics & Character Exhibition (S.P.A.C.E.) 2025

We will be holding our annual PE, Art and Music learning carnival, Space for Physical, Aesthetics & Character Exhibition (SPACE) 2026, at the end of Term 2. The carnival aims to promote physical activity and artistic expression, while nurturing values such as excellence, integrity, and perseverance.

This year, the SPACE will be a collaboration with the Education and Career Guidance (ECG) committee, with the aim of helping students better understand the skills and aptitudes associated with careers in Sports and Aesthetics. (10) Monthly Focal Value for May – Integrity

The Monthly Focal Value Programme aims to build the character of our students by purposefully instilling in them our school's core values. In May, we will be focusing on the value of "Integrity". Students will be guided to uphold integrity in their daily school life by taking responsibility for their own learning and behaviour, acting with integrity even in the absence of supervision, and being upstanders who encourage and support their peers to do what is right. For middle and upper primary levels, students will also be guided to understand and demonstrate the focal value of **Integrity** during activities such as the NAPFA tests, weighted assessments and P5 overseas immersion trip to Taiwan, as well as when representing the school in competitions such as National School Games (NSG) by conducting themselves with honesty, fairness and a strong sense of responsibility.

We believe that instilling integrity in our students is crucial for their character development. Students will understand the importance of upholding honesty, demonstrating moral courage as well as acting with sincerity and accountability. The value of integrity is also key to developing trusting relationships and building a positive learning environment for everyone.

We seek your partnership in integrating this value into your child's daily life at home. The table below illustrates how your child can demonstrate integrity in the day-to-day interactions with his/her family members. Parents can also refer to page 14 of the school diary for the same table.

9) 台湾学习之旅及成都线上学习之旅

我校将有一组由 8 名老师和 34 名五年级学生组成的团队将于 5 月 21 日至 5 月 26 日前往台湾台北，在当地的台北市内湖区内湖国民小学进行学习之旅。另外一所学校，台北景美国小的学生也将于今年 5 月 12 日到我校进行交流。

此外，五年级的学生还将于 5 月 19 日在上课时间参与中国成都的线上学习之旅。

10) 五月份月度焦点价值观 – 正直

我校的“月度焦点价值观计划”旨在通过有意识地灌输学校的核心价值观来培养学生的品格。在五月份，我们将把焦点集中在“正直”这一价值观上。

学生将学习在日常校园生活中坚持正直，对自己的学习与行为负责，在没有监督的情况下也能做出正确的选择，并勇于支持和鼓励同伴做正确的事。对于中年级及高年级学生，学校也将通过各项活动引导他们理解并实践正直的价值观，例如在全国体能测验(NAPFA)、计分式评价及五年级台湾海外浸濡学习之旅中，以及代表学校参加如全国校际运动会 (NSG) 等比赛时，做到诚实守信、公平对待他人，并以负责任的态度规范自己的行为。
